We hope that you will be able to participate in the return of what was a very popular and successful annual event. Due to limited space we are unable to accommodate any spectators and will only allow a maximum of two coaches/helpers per club.

**EVENTS:** 100m all strokes, 50m butterfly (11 and under), 100m IM

**AGE GROUPS:** 9-11 years, 12 & 13 years, 14 & over. Age on the day of the meet.

Events will be swum with age groups combined and seeded on entry times.

Results will be reported by age group.

All events are HDW.

NO SWIMMERS PERMITTED TO SWIM UNDER THE AGE OF 9

**AWARDS:** Medals to be awarded to 1st, 2nd, 3rd placed in each age group for each event

for males and open, and females.

**OFFICIALS:** We ask that clubs entering please indicate officials willing to officiate at this

event. We ask that officials bring a refillable water bottle.

**GENERAL** The meet shall be held under S.A.S.A. rules.

**INFORMATION** All entrants must have paid their membership fee to SASA or equivalent body.

**ADDITIONAL** Please remove outdoor footwear before entering the changing area. **INFORMATION** No outdoor shoes on poolside.

Small bags only on poolside. No food to be taken on poolside.

**TRANSGENDER & NON-BINARY:** 

As of 1 January 2024, the Scottish Swimming Transgender & Non-Binary Competition Policy was implemented nationally across all aquatics sports. The policy and FAQs can be found here. Any policy related matters that arise during the event should be reported to and will be recorded by the Meet Convenor/Lead Referee and these matters will be communicated to and managed post event by the relevant Scottish Swimming Staff. At no point will members be challenged on the day of a competition with any matters being resolved post event. As a result of this policy being implemented, any competitor intending to compete within the Female category at this event will be required to provide confirmation that their birth sex is female when signing up to the meet conditions through entry. By entering the Female category, athletes are therefore confirming their birth sex is female and are eligible to

compete in the Female category.

#### PHOTOGRAPHY STATEMENT

#### **DUNS 500**

By attending the event either as a participant, volunteer, team staff or spectator, you accept that any photographs / videos taken will not be used for illicit purposes or that pictures / films produced will not be altered in any way or uploaded onto the web without the consent in writing of the person(s) photographed / filmed. The use of mobile phones or other electronic devices capable of photography are not permitted to be used at any time in the changing village, toilets or shower areas.
