SPECIAL EVENT: East District 400metre (this event allows entrants to swim any stroke apart from

Individual Medley. The stroke to be swum *must* be declared prior to the day of swimming to the meet entries secretary) This event is open to categories A-O

(25yrs and over)

RELAYS: Mixed 4 X 50metre Freestyle and Medley Relays

INDIVIDUAL EVENTS: £5.00 per individual event OR £20.00 For 5 individual events

EAST DISTRICT 400: £5.00 (this is a stand alone event) and not included in the discounted individual

SPRINTS: Trophy for Top Male and Female FINA points scorer in any one of the

50metre events.

400m CHAMPIONSHIP: Awards to the male and female masters (25+) closest to or exceeding, in

percentage terms, the Australian Masters national record for his/her

age group and chosen stroke.

TOP JUNIOR TEAM: Trophy for Top Team in the 16-17 year category. Points awarded as above

for the individual events.

PLEASE NOTE: Whilst the 16 - 17 year old individual swims have their own Team Trophy,

points gained by any relay team which include 16 and 17 year old

swimmers will count in the overall Top Team Trophy.

<u>CATERING:</u> Cafe Facilities are available throughout the day at the venue.

BUFFET/ PRESENTATIONS:

The buffet and all presentations will take place at the end of the competition.

• Buffet cost is included for those entering and paying for 5 individual events.

• Relay participants not taking part in and paying for individual swims should purchase buffet tickets at a cost of £5.00.

 - 4. I further undertake at all times to take all reasonable safety measures for the protection of myself and fellow swimmers and to inform the Referee of any concerns I may have as regards safety.
 - 5. I acknowledge that the organisers of the East Of Scotland Open Masters Championships cannot be held responsible for any loss or damage to personal belongings and that I must take all reasonable steps against any such loss or damage.
