EVENTS 50m, 100m & 200m all strokes
200m & 400m IM
400m Freestyle
50m Skins

Swimmers must swim in their own age group for all events. All events are heat declared winners. It may be necessary to limit the number of heats in certain events.

AGE GROUPS **11 years & under, 12/13 years, 14/15 years, 16 years & over**
Skins: 14 years & under, 15 years & over
Minimum age for entering the meet is 8 years
Age as on last day of meet - 10th February 2024.

SESSIONS There will be 4 sessions as follows:
Morning: warm-up - 09.00 start - 10.00
Afternoon: warm-up - 13.30 start - 14.30

ENTRIES All entries & current times should be made on the relevant electronic file.

Any over-subscribed entries or reserve swims that are not offered a swim will be refunded in full.

Any withdrawals after the confirmed swims have been circulated to the clubs will not be eligible for a refund.

SKINS Entry into the skins event will be offered to the top 6 placed swimmers from the 200m IM event held in the morning session. If any swimmer does not wish to participate in the skins event then the next fastest swimmer will be offered the place.

At the end of each heat the 2 slowest swimmers will be eliminated until there are only 2 swimmers. The final 2 swimmers will go head-to-head to produce a winner.

The stroke for the first heat will be drawn by the referee. The stroke for each heat will be drawn by the eliminated swimmer from the previous heat.

Age groups for the skins finals will be **14 years & under** and **15 years & over**.

OFFICIALS Each club should supply at least 2 swimming technical officials, at least one of which, should ideally be a judge for each Session to assist with accreditation of meet. A SignupGenius form for STO's will be provided after the entry closing date.

AWARDS Medals will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd places in all events.
£50 cash prize to the winners of the skins events.

The FIRST OPEN Meet Shield will be presented to the **TOP TEAM** with the most points at the end of the meet. Trophy to be returned after 1 year.



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GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Meet to be held under SASA rules. Enclosed is a health and safety form to be completed (mandatory).
2. All swimmers of Scottish clubs must have a S.A.S.A. number.
3. All swimmers of non Scottish clubs must have registration with their governing body.
4. Composite Squads are allowed and are eligible for top club/team trophy
5. No swimmer under the age of 8 years is permitted to swim in accordance with licence requirements.
6. Start sheets will be available to clubs prior to the start of each session.
7. Electronic timing will be in operation. In the event of electronic failure, back-up manual timing will be used.
8. Withdrawals must be notified to the recorders no later than 40 minutes prior to the start of each session.
9. Once start sheets have been prepared no alterations shall be made.
10. It is the swimmers responsibility to check with the marshals in the allocated area. Swimmers should report to the Marshalls four heats in advance of their race.
11. Swimmers, coaches and team managers must ensure that all their swimmers can safely dive into the deep water as prescribed by current legislation.
12. There will be a maximum of two reserve swimmers for each event and no time only swims on the day. Would clubs also note that under no circumstances should any swimmer other than the one named on the start sheet go to the marshalling area.
13. No photographic or video equipment will be allowed in any area under the jurisdiction of the meet organizers without prior approval of the meet director. Application must be made on the approved SASA form.
14. Swimmers must act on the instructions given by the meet officials and behave in a reasonable manner at all times.
15. It is the responsibility of each club to ensure that their swimmers are aware of meet rules.
16. The Meet Management reserves the right to alter the programme and warm-up times if necessary. Anything not covered above or printed in the event programme will be at the gala convenor's discretion.
17. The convenor reserves the right to restrict entries in order to facilitate the smooth running of the meet. Entries will be accepted on time basis. Clubs should ensure entry times are accurate. Rejected entries will be refunded in full.
18. Swimmers and Coaches must not take glassware into the showers or onto poolside otherwise they will be liable for expulsion from the meet.
19. FIRST Committee, nor Grangemouth Sports Complex cannot be held responsible for loss or damage to swimmers, team staff or spectator's property. Swimmers are strongly advised to secure property in the lockers provided in changing rooms and not to leave belongings lying around unattended.
20. Swimmers out with the pool side must wear dry clothing and footwear at all times.
21. Outdoor footwear must not be worn at poolside.

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CONTROLLING THE USE OF PHOTOGRAPHIC EQUIPMENT

Scottish Amateur Swimming Association has decided that control of photographic equipment is required at all meets.

In view of this, the meet will run under the following guidelines:

- No photographic equipment (e.g. Camera, Camcorder, etc) is to be allowed on poolside, spectator gallery or any other area under the jurisdiction of the meet organisers without prior approval of the meet director.
- Application to use photographic equipment must be made on the approved SASA form.
- Application can be made on the day to the meet director or to the meet directors appointed official. Applicant must provide proof of identity when applying and carry such proof when intending to use their photographic equipment.
- In order to comply with accreditation and health and safety requirements, this form must be completed and returned along with entry information.

HEALTH AND SAFETY ANNOUNCEMENT

I confirm that all the entered swimmers have paid their current SASA Annual Competitive Fee.

I understand that any swimmer entered without an SASA number will be automatically rejected.

I confirm that all entered swimmers have been trained and are competent to dive into deep or shallow water in a safe manner as prescribed by current/planned legislation.

I confirm that information regarding the use of photographic equipment has been passed on to swimmers and parents intending to travel to the meet.
